Curriculum update:

Class 1 – This week in Reception we have focused on the story, It Was A Cold Dark Night. We have sorted a range of animals in to nocturnal and diurnal and learnt about which ones hibernate. In maths we have looked really carefully at the numbers 3 and 4. We have used dice and numicon to make these numbers in lots of different ways.

Class 2 – This week in literacy we have been writing acrostic poems based on Autumn, we have also looked at letter writing skills and written letters to our pen pals at Bollington Cross. In maths we have been looking at addition and subtraction. In our topic work we have been investigating how our tongues work and labelling diagrams. We have tasted the four main tastes and decided which ones were our favourite.

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Class 3 – This week, in maths, children have looked at inverse operation and simple word problems. In literacy, children have created a non-chronological report based on Ancient Egyptian gods and pharaohs. In IPC, children have started to create their Egyptian death masks.

Class 4 – This week, Class 4 have been looking at compact methods for multiplication and division in maths. In English we have been completing final drafts of our stories and researching the five decades St John's has been open on this site, in preparation for our celebration next Thursday. We also enjoyed visiting St Oswald's church for Eucharist and our trip to Chester Cathedral.

Sports News – This week we have had another excellent week of PE. Class 1 showed how well they could catch and throw in the morning together with some great gymnastic work on the matts in the afternoon. Class 2 had a great morning outside performing throwing and catching with a fab game of dodgeball to finish. In the afternoon they again showed how controlled they are on the gymnastic apparatus. Class 3 had an afternoon of hockey skills and hockey matches. Class 4 had a fitness circuit class full of boxing skipping press-ups and core work with hockey match play to finish in the afternoon. Plus a special mention to the boys and girls who represented the school in a football match against beech hall on Wednesday, a big well done.
