Curriculum update:

Class 1 – This week in Reception we have started our new topic of Paws, Claws and Whiskers. We have focused on the story of The Messy Magpie which looks at the impact of humans littering on the environment and animals homes. We have written speech bubbles for some of the animals showing how they feel about their environment being destroyed. In maths we have started looking at weighing; we have focused initially on balancing the scales using different objects on each side. We also made the most of the good weather and used the water tray to introduce capacity. We measured out the water using a range of cylinders and containers. We have been practicing for our talent show entry all week.

Class 2 – This week in literacy we have been started our new Class story called "Toby and the great fire". We have looked at paintings of the Great fire of London and used these to start some setting descriptions using our senses. In maths we have been partitioning two digit numbers using part whole diagrams. In IPC we have been looking at language relating to time, creating our own personal timelines and creating a giant class timeline.

Class 3 – In maths, children have recapped column method and applied their learning to word problems. In literacy, we have started a new book 'Fantastic Mr. Fox'. Children have thought about different techniques writers use to grab the readers' attention. In IPC, we have started a new topic of 'How the Human Body works'. On Friday, children completed a 'body MOT' measuring weight, height, arm span, heart rate and blood pressure.

Class 4 – This week, we have been revising addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of fractions in maths. In English, we have been reading 'The Boy in the Tower' by Polly Ho-Yen and planning a newspaper report which we will be writing next week. In IPC, we have started our new topic, 'The Holiday Show'. We have discussed different types of holidays and what types of destinations different tourists may want.

Sports News – Class 1 and Class 2 has a joint PE session this week and made the most of the sunshine, they practiced their ball skills and played football games. Class 3 were out on the field dribbling footballs and playing some football matches. Class 4 had a possession and space finding session whilst playing football.
