

Curriculum update:

Class 1 – This week in Reception we have focused on homes in different countries and the similarities and differences to our homes in Bollington. We have looked at the shapes and materials for each home and what properties each material has to make it suitable for house building in that country. In maths we have focused on the number 15 which led to us counting in 5's and 10's using a hundred square. We have used clay to start making our own models of Kenyan mud huts.

Class 2 – This week in literacy we have made booklets about the history of canals. We have also written recounts about our walk down the Bollington canal. In maths we have been reading and writing numbers as words up to 100. In IPC we have learnt all about locks and canal boats and had a lovely sunny walk down the canal to see the boats, paying particular attention to the Roses and Castles artwork that we have been learning about.

Class 3 – This week, in maths, children have worked on measuring angles and recapping the different types of triangle. In literacy, children have started to create a newspaper report based on the mysterious crime scene that appeared in the Class 3 Allotment on Wednesday. In IPC, children have thought about the link between the rotation of the Earth and our day/night cycle.

Class 4 – This week, in maths, we have been revising long multiplication and division methods, and looking at how to solve problems using a logical approach. In English, we have been writing contrasting diary entries in role as characters from the class novel we are currently reading. We have also been rehearsing for the leavers' play.

Sports News – Looking to sports day this week and all classes had a rehearsal for their sports day! Well done to all and good luck to everyone today!
