#### **Curriculum update**

**Class 1 St John's** – This week we have focussed on language relating to preposition so we looked at a story called Rosie's Walk by Pat Hutchins. We used pictures from the story to help us write sentences. In maths we have looked at 3D shapes. Our quail eggs have now been in the incubator for one week and are developing well. We enjoyed World Book Day - the costumes were fantastic!

Class 1 Pott Shrigley — This week in Literacy, Class 1 have been looking at instructions; they have been reading, writing and following all different types of instructions in preparation for a special day on Sunday. In Maths, we have been looking at finding 10 more and 10 less than a number as well as round a number to the nearest 10. Class 1 have worked hard on their pieces of art to show different parts of our Earth, such as; flowers, leaves, trees and different types of animals. They have become increasingly confident with this science module and continue to surprise us with their fantastic knowledge and understanding.

**Class 2 St John's** – This week we were lucky enough to go to St Oswald's church for our Easer experience. We had such a fantastic time, have a look on our website to see some photographs. In maths we have been doing column addition and in topic work we have begun identifying where the different rainforests are found in the world.

**Class 2 Pott Shrigley** – Class 2 have been preparing a descriptive piece of writing based on the Amazon Rainforest. We have looked at adverbial phrases and other techniques to improve our writing.

**Class 3 St John's** – We have been exploring the features of persuasive writing in English, and we have designed a persuasive poster. We also enjoyed celebrating World Book Day. In Maths, we have looked at volume and comparing fractions by finding common denominators. We have also enjoyed our church visit, and the Year 5 and 6s had a Safety Presentation.

**Class 3 Pott Shrigley** – It has been an exciting week in Class 3! On Tuesday we went to St. Oswald's for an Easter experience and we re-enacted the Easter story. On Wednesday, Year 6 went to Tytherington High School for a transition event, 'Mission Impossible', and on Thursday we had World Book Day. In Literacy, we have written persuasive letters to Mrs Walker. In Maths, we have looked at distance time line graphs
